**SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY'S (U 338-E)
LATE-FILED NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION
IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 8.3**

Southern California Edison Company (“SCE”) hereby submits this late-filed notice of an *ex parte* communication in accordance with Rule 8.3 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure.¹ SCE representatives met with Commissioner Dian Grueneich on Tuesday, September 23, 2008, at the United States Department of Interior, 1849 C Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20240, and the United States Department of Agriculture, Whitten Federal Building, Room 217E, 12th and Jefferson Streets, S.W. On September 19, 2008, SCE provided an advance notice of *ex parte* communication as required by Rule 8.2 prior to the meeting. The communication was oral.

Mr. Les Starck, SCE’s Vice President of Local Public Affairs, spoke at a meeting with the Department of Interior and a meeting with the Department of Agriculture in Washington, D.C., both of which were also attended by Commissioner Dian Grueneich. Mr. Starck encouraged the agencies to allocate resources to ensure timely receipt of Federal permits for the Devers-Palo Verde No. 2 and the Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Projects. Mr. Starck

provided an overview on the status of the projects, and SCE's applications for Federal permits that would allow construction of the Devers-Palo Verde No. 2 and the Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Projects, as shown in Attachment 1. Although Mr. Starck did not speak individually to Ms. Grueneich during the overview to the Federal Agencies, SCE representatives provided Commissioner Grueneich a copy of Attachment 1.

Devers-Palo Verde No. 2 Transmission Project U.S. Bureau of Land Management Record of Decision U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service ESA Consultation

**Southern California Edison
September 23, 2008**

Issue: SCE is seeking to construct the Devers – Palo Verde No. 2 (DPV2) 500 kV Transmission Line (the “Project) from California to Arizona. The proposed Project consists of two transmission lines, a 225-mile line from the Palo Verde area within Arizona to SCE’s Devers substation in Palm Springs, California, and a 42-mile line from the Devers Substation to the Valley Substation in Romoland, California. The proposed route would cross about 25 miles of the Kofa National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) in Arizona and about 110 total miles of U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) administered land in both states. The transmission line would parallel SCE’s existing DPV1 and Devers - Valley No. 1 500 kV transmission lines. SCE requests that BLM and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) complete the review process for the Project and complete processing the requested authorizations for the Project. Specifically, the BLM should issue a Record of Decision (ROD) on the Project and the FWS should issue a decision on the administrative appeal challenging the FWS issued right-of-way across the Kofa NWR.

Background: In 2005, SCE filed applications with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), the BLM, and the FWS for authorizations to construct DPV2. In October 2006, the CPUC and BLM completed the joint Final Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) for the Project. The CPUC approved the Project, issuing a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in January 2007. Prior to issuing an amended Right of Way permit, the BLM is required to complete consultation under both (i) the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) Section 106, and (ii) the ESA Section 7. BLM has not yet completed these consultations.

In June, 2007, the ACC denied SCE’s request to construct DPV2 in Arizona. SCE plans to file a new application with the ACC for constructing DPV2 in Arizona in early 2009, and is similarly undertaking the approval process before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) for this Project. Additionally, to facilitate access to planned renewable generation in the eastern California desert and to meet state renewable generation requirements, SCE has requested CPUC authorization to build the California portion of DPV2.

FWS ESA Consultation

The FWS discontinued consultation under the ESA after the ACC denied SCE’s application to construct DPV2 in Arizona. Neither SCE nor the BLM requested that the FWS discontinue consultation. The FWS has indicated that it would reinitiate consultation upon written request from the BLM. If the BLM makes such a request in the near future, it may be possible for the FWS to complete ESA consultation by March 2009.

FWS Kofa NWR Right of Way Grant

In May 2007, the FWS Regional Director (Southwest Regional Office) overturned the Refuge Manager's decision and found the DPV2 Project is compatible with the Kofa NWR. The Regional Director then issued a Right of Way permit to SCE for the portion of the Project within the Kofa NWR. The Arizona Center for Law in the Public Interest filed an administrative appeal with the FWS Director challenging that permit. The Director needs to decide that administrative appeal.

BLM ROD

To date, the BLM has not yet issued a ROD. The NHPA consultation is nearing completion, pending BLM and the Arizona State Historic Preservation Office review of proposed preferred and alternative communication sites in Arizona. SCE seeks an expeditious and prioritized conclusion of the FWS ESA Section 7 consultation and the NHPA Section 106 requirements.

Requested Action: SCE requests that:

1. The BLM reinstate Section 7 consultation with the FWS. The FWS should provide sufficient support so that the ESA Section 7 consultation is completed in a timely fashion.
2. The FWS Director decide the Arizona Center for Law in the Public Interest administrative appeal that challenges the May 18, 2007 ROW permit to SCE for the DPV2 project through the Kofa NWR.
3. The BLM issue a decision within 30 days after both the ESA Section 7 consultation and NHPA Section 106 requirements are completed.
