



Interconnection Facilities Agreement with Corona.<sup>2</sup> The Commission ordered SCE to submit a compliance filing within thirty days of the January 11 Order that “utilize[s] the *pro forma* Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (LGIA) as required by the Commission’s Order Nos. 2003 and 2003-A rather than the Interconnection Agreement filed herein.”<sup>3</sup>

Since the January 11 Order, SCE has entered into discussions with Corona, drafted the LGIA appendices, and, after internal review and discussion, sent the draft LGIA, including the appendices, to Corona on February 2, 2005. On February 4, 2005, SCE requested a thirty day extension of time to file the compliance filing so that the parties would have sufficient time to negotiate the LGIA and, hopefully, file an executed LGIA. The Commission granted SCE’s request on February 8, 2004.

On February 18, 2005, the Commission issued its Order Accepting In Part and Rejecting In Part Proposed Modifications to *Pro Forma* Large Generator Interconnection Procedures and Large Generator Interconnection Agreement in Docket No. ER04-435-006.<sup>4</sup> In the February 18 Order, the Commission rejected numerous provisions that were included in SCE’s *pro forma* WDAT LGIA, as well as in the modified Corona LGIA. In light of the February 18 Order, SCE believes that it would be more prudent for it to file the Corona LGIA *after* the Commission has accepted SCE’s filing in compliance with the February 18 Order in Docket ER04-435, so that (1) it can conform the Corona LGIA to

the accepted compliance filing in Docket ER04-435; (2) Corona has an opportunity to review the FERC-accepted *pro forma* LGIA that SCE ultimately will file to comply with the February 18 Order; and (3) Corona, the Commission, and SCE do not waste further time and resources negotiating and reviewing a form of the LGIA that, has not been, at least in concept, accepted by the Commission.

The Commission's grant of this extension of time will not prejudice the Parties, as Corona is currently interconnected and receiving Distribution Service under SCE's WDAT. Thus, this extension of time would be in the best interests of the Parties, as well as the Commission.<sup>5</sup> Corona has indicated that it will not oppose the extension of time proposed herein, and has further indicated to SCE that it feels it would be more beneficial for SCE and Corona to enter into one final agreement which has been accepted by the Commission in its entirety. Neither party desires to have the terms of its filed agreement potentially change once the Commission has issued a final order.




